## ENCEPHALARTOS *gratus*

A medium to large sized cycad usually single stems but also in clumps of up to 8 stems with suckers produced from the base. Easy to cultivate and growth is very rapid

Trunks to 2.5 metres tall

60 cm

2 metres long - dark green

Occurs in south-east Malawi and north western Mozambique, South Africa

Tropical and subtropical and perhaps warm temperate regions. Plants will grow in sun but have a better appearance if given partial protection
