ENCEPHALARTOS *kisambo*

A medium sized clumping cycad which is regarded as one of the most spectacular cycad species. A majestic, fast growing species. Cones are a very attractive canary yellow

Trunks to 4 metres tall

60 cm

2 – 4 metres long - soapy green

Endemic to southern Kenya where it is restricted to isolated mountains in the Voi district

Tropical and subtropical and warm temperate regions. Plants can be grown in full sun but best appearance is obtained with some protection
