DIOON mejiae

Beautiful and decorative small to medium sized cycad. Its ease in horticulture, adaptability to both sun and shade, and some cold tolerance make this cycad an exceptional landscape plant. Will develop into a sizeable plant in a relatively short time

Trunks to 1+ metres

25 cm

1 – 2 metres long – dark green

Occurs in Honduras and has also recently been collected in north central Nicaragua

Tropical, subtropical and perhaps temperate regions. This species has been reported to survive temperatures down to -5°C
