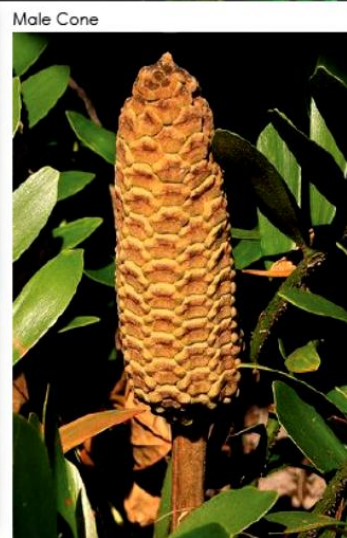
0.5 – 1.5 metres long-olive green to brownish green
